Eligibility in Categories:

All nominees must be Australian citizens and reside within the Barcoo Shire Council area at the time of nomination.

Award Categories:

Citizen of the Year

Eligible nominees must be 26 years or older as of 26 January 2022

Recognises an individual for their outstanding contribution to the Barcoo community during the preceding year, or given outstanding services to the local community over several years.

Young Citizen of the Year

Eligible nominees must be 25 years or younger as of 26 January 2022

Recognises a young individual who has made a noteworthy contribution during the current year and/or given outstanding service to the local community over several years.

Community Event of the Year

Nominated events must have been held in the Barcoo Shire between January 2021 and December 2021 and is awarded to an event that has made an outstanding contribution to the community within the Barcoo Shire Council area during 2021.

Volunteer of the Year

In recognition of a Barcoo Shire resident of any age who has devoted considerable time to volunteering for the community during the 2021 year and /or who has an outstanding record of volunteering for the community over a number of years.

Senior Sports Award

Eligible nominees must be 26 years or older as of 26 January 2022

In recognition of a Barcoo Shire resident who has achieved significant sporting success during the 2020 year or has an outstanding record of sporting achievement over a number of years.

Junior Sports Award

Eligible nominees must be 25 years or younger as of 26 January 2022

In recognition of a Barcoo Shire resident who has achieved significant sporting success during the 2020 year or has an outstanding record of sporting achievement over a number of years.

Cultural Award

In recognition of people who have made a noteworthy contribution to the cultural life of the community or an outstanding achievement in cultural activity.
