Colour      White on Green  
Size         140mm wide

\* Signs should indicate the name and distance of each property on the road as well as the turn-offs.

- *Signs of Road Names and Creeks*

Colour      Black on White  
Size         140mm wide

- *Property Signs*

- Property Listing Signs

Colour White on Green

Size 100mm wide

- Property Advise Signs

Colour White on Green

Size 140mm wide

- *Information Signs*

Colour White on Green

Size 140mm wide

- *Tourism Signs*

Colour White on Brown

Size 140mm wide

- *Other Signs*

Colour White on Maroon
